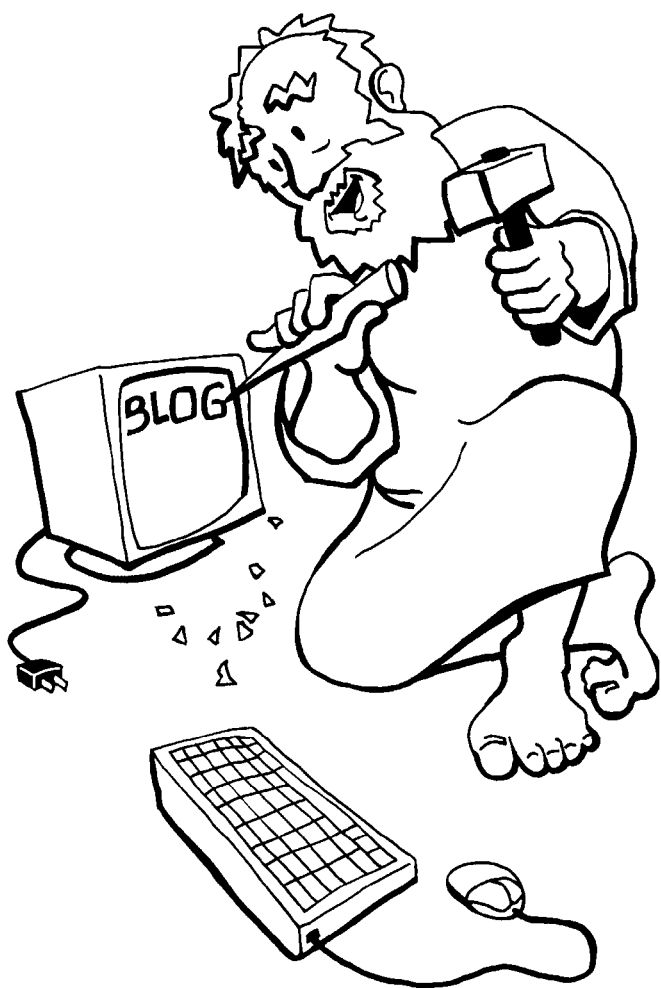


# MOSES BLOGS .com

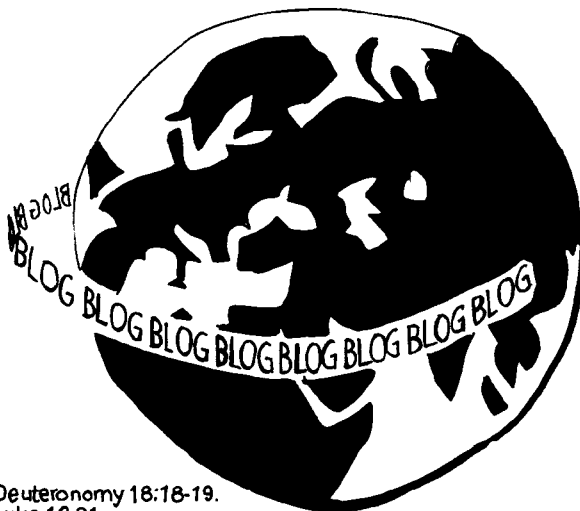

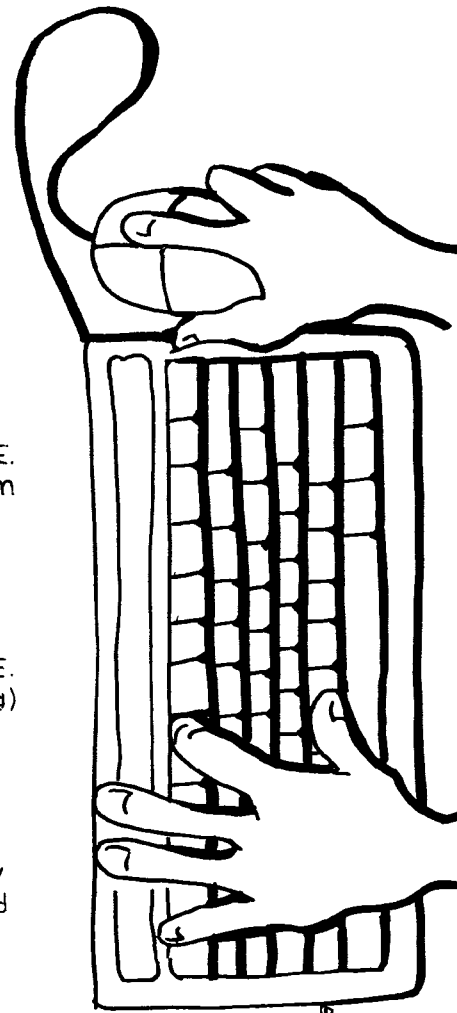
